Soccer, Field Hockey, Basketball, Baseball and Softball

- Tryouts are open to all 6th-8th Grade Knollwood students.
- There will be informational parent meetings, regarding tryouts, prior to each athletic season.
- Tryouts will be a two or three day format. Students will be notified at the end of the tryout week, via the Athletics webpage, whether they made the team.
- Participants should be on time each day to tryouts.
- Attending all tryout sessions is not mandatory. Attending all tryout sessions will definitely help showcase your skills to the observers/judges.
- Tryouts will be closed to the public.
- Knollwood School will provide multiple observers/judges during the tryout sessions.
- Parental contact with the tryout observers/judges is prohibited during the tryout week.
- Observers/judges will follow tryout lesson plans and rubrics.
- Score sheets/rubrics remain the property of Knollwood School and will not be given to the participating students or to their parents.
- Participants and parents may request a tryout feedback ***email*** from the coach. Coaches will provide feedback emails during the school week. If an email is received over the weekend, the coach will respond to the email the following school week.
- Prior year's team membership does not guarantee a spot on the team for the following year. All students must tryout year-after-year.
- Current grade levels do not guarantee a student a spot on the team. All students must tryout year-after-year.
- Being a student volunteer Team Manager does not guarantee a spot on the team during the following year.
